### Conservation funding opportunity for private landholders in three locations across NSW

The NSW Biodiversity Conservation Trust (BCT) today announced the launch of three new conservation tenders during 2021 in the Lower Clarence Valley, the Paroo and Warrego Catchments, and the Snowy Monaro local government area.

The BCT Board's acting Chair Ms Virginia Malley is encouraging all eligible landholders to submit an expression of interest during the open tender period.

"The BCT's conservation tenders encourage and reward private landholders to participate in biodiversity conservation," said Ms Malley.

## Landcare Led Bushfire Recovery Grants

Eligible local Landcare groups, environment networks and community groups working on bushfire recovery projects can now access funding of approximately \$50,000 – and Landscape scale partnerships projects of up to approximately \$300,000 in a landmark new grants program

funded by the Australian Government Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment.

The \$14 million Landcare Led Bushfire Recovery Grants program is supporting Landcare bushfire recovery projects in seven government-designated bushfire regions across Queensland, New South Wales, the Australian Capital Territory, Victoria and South Australia impacted by the Black Summer bushfires of 2019/2020.

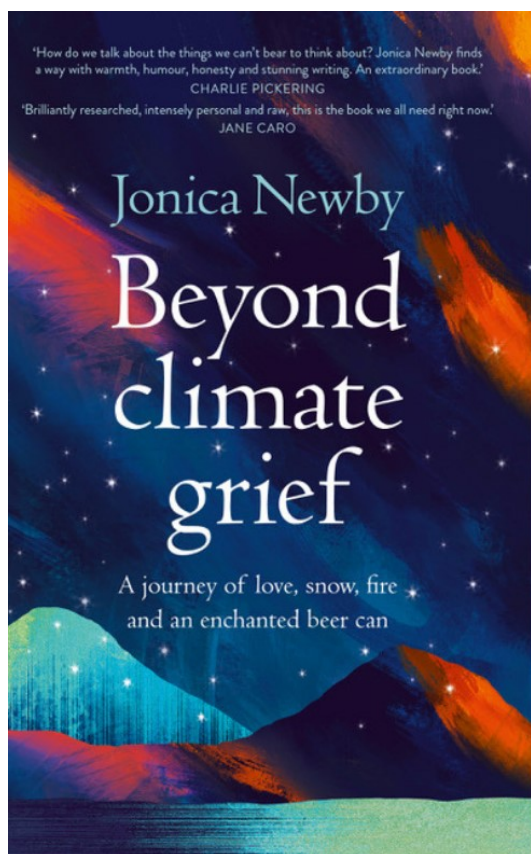


Remember Dr Jonica Newby from ABC TV's Catalyst?

On 10 June you can meet her in person at Grafton Library to discuss her latest book *Beyond climate grief: a journey of love, snow, fire and an enchanted beer can*. This book stemmed partly from Jonica's visit to Nymboida in the Clarence Valley during the 2019 fires and presents a story of rare honesty and intimacy. *Beyond Climate Grief* charts her struggles navigating the emotional turmoil of climate change, and provides guidance and emotional sustenance to help us all face the uncertainties ahead. Guaranteed laughs, tears surprising stories and food for the soul as Jonica talks about what propelled her to write the book, and her quest for answers during the apocalyptic summer of 2019 / 2020.

Dr Jonica Newby is a science reporter, author, TV presenter and director best known for her two decades on ABC TV's popular weekly science program, Catalyst. She has twice won the Eureka Award, Australia's most prestigious science journalism prize, and is a recipient of a World TV Award.
